



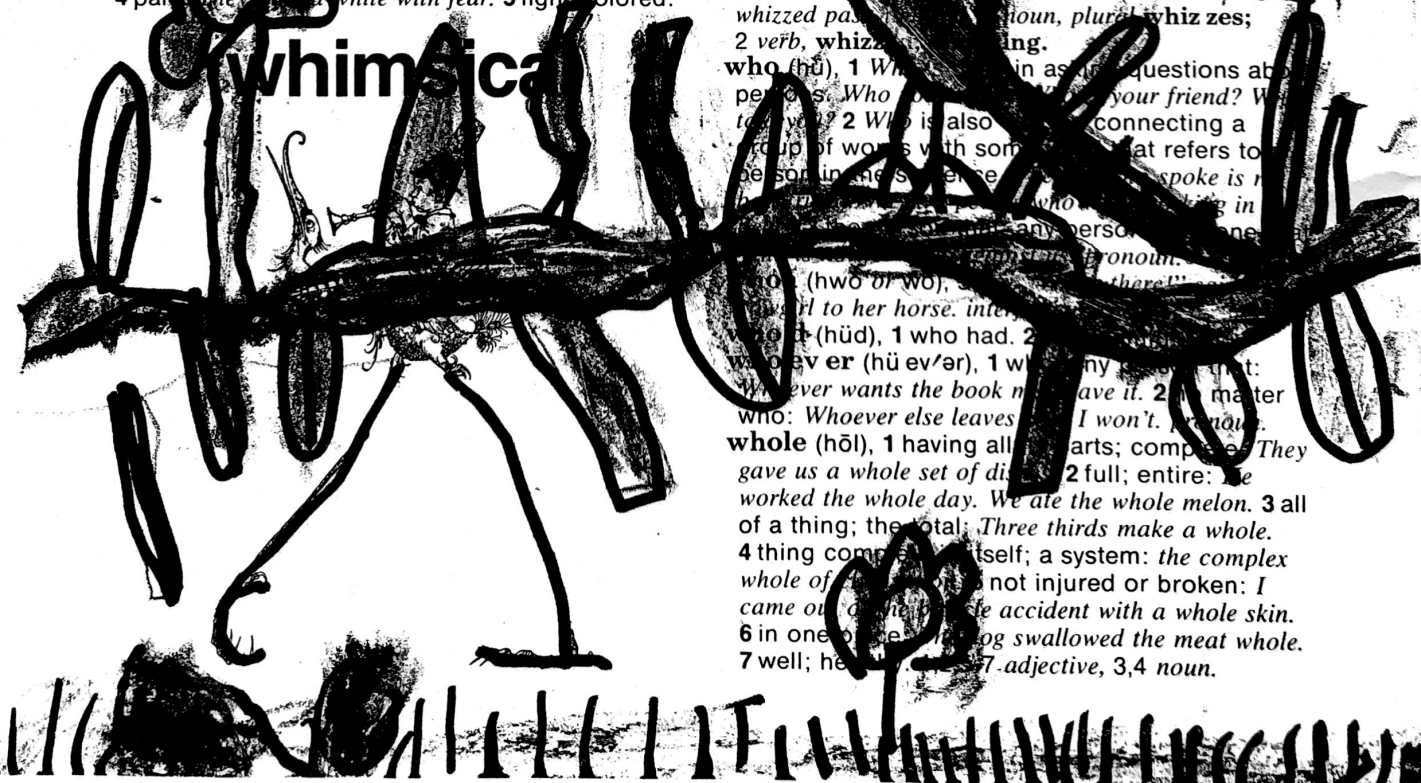
whippoorwill - about 10 inches (25 centimeters) long

whither (wɪðər), where; to what place; to what direction. conjunction.

whitish (wɪtɪʃ), somewhat white. adjective.

whittle (wɪtl̩), 1 shavings or chips from wood. 2 usually for fun. 2 cut or shape wood. 3 learned how to whittle. verb, whittled, whittling.

whizz (wɪz), 1 whizzing or hissing sound. 2 move or pass with a sound: An arrow whizzed past. noun, plural whizzes; 2 verb, whizzed, whizzing.

who (hu), 1 Who is in as many questions as persons: Who is your friend? Who is your teacher? 2 Who is also used in connecting a group of words with some word that refers to a person in the sentence: The person who spoke is not here.

whoever (hu ev/ər), 1 who or any person that: Whoever wants the book may have it. 2 matter who: Whoever else leaves I won't. pronoun.

whole (hōl), 1 having all parts; complete: They gave us a whole set of dishes. 2 full; entire: He worked the whole day. We ate the whole melon. 3 all of a thing; the total: Three thirds make a whole. 4 thing complete in itself; a system: the complex whole of the human mind. 5 not injured or broken: I came out of the car accident with a whole skin. 6 in one piece: The dog swallowed the meat whole. 7 well; healthy. 1-7 adjective, 3,4 noun.
